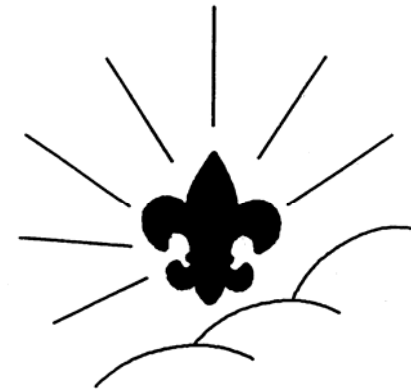




**Troop 626
